


Lung Health Training and Education Framework



The time to improve lung health in Australia is **now**.

The Thoracic Society of Australia and New Zealand, Lung Foundation Australia, Asthma Australia, and healthcare professionals are designing and delivering a **competency-based training and education framework for lung health**. It is a part of a Commonwealth Government, Department of Health, grant to achieve part 3.1 of the [National Strategic Action Plan 2019](#).

The Framework's Purpose

- Equip primary healthcare professionals with the knowledge and the skills to deliver optimal patient care and improve health outcomes in individuals living with a lung condition/s.
- Support the upskilling of primary healthcare professionals resulting in improved identification, diagnosis, and management of lung conditions.

Broader Stakeholder Forums

We are engaging and communicating with primary healthcare professionals by establishing broader stakeholder forums. We are seeking membership from people with knowledge of lung conditions and health-related education.



The forums' purpose:

- Represent the interests of primary healthcare professionals
- Offer relevant professional experiences/insight relating to their community, practice and patients
- Make suggestions which may include but are not limited to the Framework's design, marketing and communications and engagement.

Applicants are encouraged to:

- Have lung health and education experience, particularly in training and competency-based frameworks
- A connection to primary care networks and professional organisations
- Represent other's views with objectivity
- Be reliable, responsible, and willing to commit time to attend scheduled meetings.
